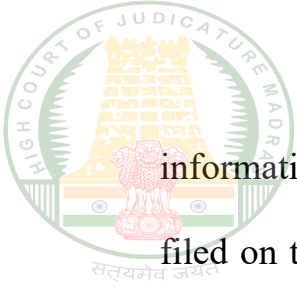

ORDER

By consent of both parties, this writ petition is taken up for final disposal at the admission stage itself.

2. This writ petition has been filed for a direction, directing the 3rd respondent to dispose the second appeal S.A.No.8184/D/2025.

3. It is the case of the petitioner that the petitioner sought for certain



information from the first respondent, since, there was no action, appeal was filed on the file of the second respondent and letter was given to the petitioner stating that information could not be given.
