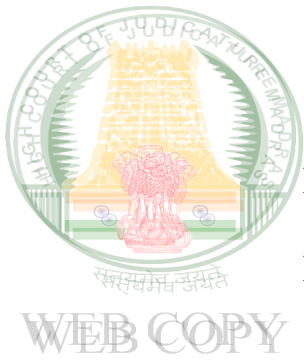

Prayer: This writ petition is filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, praying to issue a Writ of Mandamus directing the respondents to act upon the petitioner's application and representation dated 21.01.2026 and 23.03.2026 to survey and fix the boundaries for the petitioners land viz all that Survey No.124 covering an extent of 3102 sq.ft. including a constructed terraced house situate at Baratharami Village, Gudiyattam Taluk, Vellore District and identify and fix the boundaries of the same.

This Writ Petition has been filed to direct the respondents to consider the petitioner's online application dated 21.01.2026.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner would submit that the petitioner has made an online application dated 21.01.2026 to survey and fix the boundaries for the petitioner's land viz all that Survey No.124 covering an extent of 3102 sq.ft. including a constructed terraced house situate at Baratharami Village, Gudiyattam Taluk, Vellore District. However, the same was not considered, as on date. Hence, this writ petition.

3. Mr.B.Pachaiyappan, learned Government's Counsel accepts notice on behalf of the respondents and submitted that the petitioner's application dated 21.01.2026 will be considered within a period of eight weeks.

4. Heard the learned counsel on either side and perused the materials available on record.

5. Considering the limited relief sought by the learned counsel for the



petitioner, this Court without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, directs the respondent to consider the petitioner's online application dated 21.01.2026 and carry out a survey and complete the process, after giving prior notice to the petitioner and other aggrieved parties, if any, within a period of eight (8) weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order. Further, this Court directs the petitioner to submit all the relevant documents before the respondents, if any demanded.

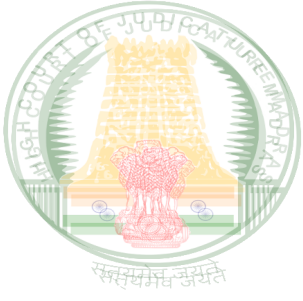
6. It is made clear that this order is passed only for the purpose of issuing a direction to the official respondent to conduct a survey and lay boundary stones at the subject land. In the event any dispute arises regarding the possession of the subject property, the same has to be decided by way of filing a suit before the competent Civil Court.

7. With the above direction, this writ petition stands disposed of. No costs.
