**Prayer:**

Writ Petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, praying to issue a Writ of Mandamus, directing the respondent to dispose petitioner representation dated 04.03.2026 and consequently issue directions to issue patta to the extent of 3 cents situated at Kovalam Village, Thiruporur SRO, Chengalpattu District in accordance with law

**ORDER**

This writ petition has been filed to direct the respondents to consider the petitioner's representation dated 04.03.2026.



2. Mr.B.Pachaiyappan, learned Government's counsel, takes notice on behalf of the respondents.

3. By consent of the parties, the main petition is taken up for disposal in the stage of admission itself.

4. The learned counsel for the petitioner would submit that in this case, the petitioner filed a representation dated 04.03.2026 before the respondent, for issuance of patta, pertaining to the subject land, in favour of the petitioner. However, the said representation was not at all considered by the respondent till date. Hence, this petition.

5. In reply, the learned counsel for the respondent would submit that the petitioner's representation will be disposed of within a period of 16 weeks and hence, he requests this Court to pass appropriate orders.

6. Heard the learned counsel appearing for the petitioner as well as the respondent and also perused the entire materials available on record.

7. In view of the above, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the matter, this Court directs the respondent to consider the representation of the



petitioner dated 04.03.2026 and after issuing due notice to all the concerned parties, dispose of the same, on merits and in accordance with law, within a period of 16 weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.

8. With the above directions, this writ petition is disposed of. No cost.
