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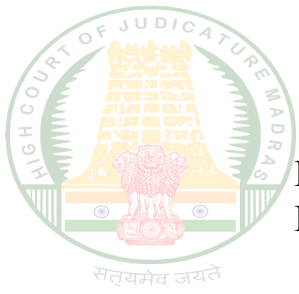

3. The condition imposed in paragraph No.7 (c) of the order dated 21.11.2025 that '*the petitioners shall appear before the Trial Court on the first working day of every English Calendar month at 10.30 a.m., until the disposal of the Criminal Revision Case*' is justified and reasonable order. Thus, there is no justification in granting any further relaxation.
