PRAYER: The Criminal Original Petition has been filed under Section 483 of B.N.S.S. praying to enlarge the petitioners on bail in connection with Cr.No.8/2026 in the file of the Respondent, All Women Police Station, Palladam Police Station, Tiruppur District.

ORDER

The petitioner, who was arrested and remanded to judicial custody on 24.03.2026 for the alleged offences under Sections 5(l), 5(j)(ii) read with 6 of



POCSO Act and Section 9 read with 10 and 11 of PCMA in Cr. No.8 of 2026

on the file of the respondent police, seeks bail.

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2. The *case of the prosecution* is that the victim girl, aged 13 years got married with the petitioner herein, aged 42 years, against her wish and the petitioner had committed forcible sexual intercourse with the victim, against her will and hence the case.

3. The learned counsel for the petitioner would submit that the petitioner is an innocent and he has been remanded to judicial custody on 24.03.2026. The learned counsel would further submit that false complaint has been lodged against the petitioner and he is ready to abide by any condition that may be imposed by this Court and hence prayed to enlarge the petitioner on bail.

4. At this juncture, the learned Government Advocate (Criminal side) appearing for the respondent police has submitted the statement of the victim girl recorded under Section 183 of B.N.S.S. and would further submit that there are serious allegations against the petitioner and therefore, strongly objected to enlarge the petitioner on bail.

5. Considering the age of the victim girl, being a minor and there are serious allegations regarding physical relationship between the petitioner and



the victim girl, the consent of the victim girl has absolutely no role to play to mitigate the seriousness of the allegations, considering the totality of circumstances and the serious allegations, this Court is not inclined to enlarge the petitioner on bail.

6. Accordingly, this Criminal Original Petition is **dismissed**.
