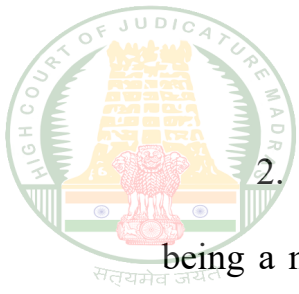

ORDER

The petitioner, who was arrested and remanded to judicial custody on 05.04.2026 for the alleged offences under Section 64(2)(m) of B.N.S. and Sections 5(1), 5(j)(ii) read with 6(1) of POCSO Act in Cr. No.97 of 2026 on the file of the respondent police, seeks bail.

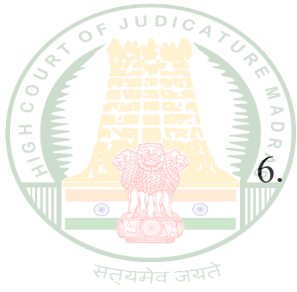


2. The *case of the prosecution* is that the petitioner, aged 39 years and being a married man, had committed aggravated penetrative sexual assault on the minor victim girl, aged 16 years, and the victim girl became pregnant and hence the case.

3. The learned counsel for the petitioner would submit that the petitioner is an innocent and he has been remanded to judicial custody on 05.04.2026. The learned counsel would further submit that false complaint has been lodged against the petitioner and he is ready to abide by any condition that may be imposed by this Court and hence prayed to enlarge the petitioner on bail.

4. At this juncture, the learned Government Advocate (Criminal side) appearing for the respondent police has submitted the statement of the victim girl recorded under Section 183 of B.N.S.S. and would further submit that there are serious allegations against the petitioner and therefore, strongly objected to enlarge the petitioner on bail.

5. The age of the petitioner is 39 years and according to the statement of the victim under Section 183 of B.N.S.S, there are serious allegations against the petitioner. Hence considering the totality of circumstances and the severity of the allegations, this Court is not inclined to enlarge the petitioner on bail.



6. Accordingly, this Criminal Original Petition is **dismissed**.
