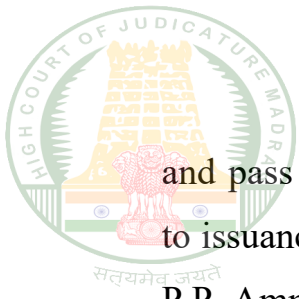

ORDER

This writ petition has been filed to direct the respondents to consider the petitioner's representation dated 09.03.2026.

2. Mr.B.Pachaiyappan, learned Government's counsel, takes notice on behalf of the respondents 1, 3 to 5 and Mr.S.Gopinath, learned Standing counsel, takes notice on behalf of the 2nd respondent.

3. By consent of the parties, the main petition is taken up for disposal in the stage of admission itself.

4. The learned counsel for the petitioner would submit that in this case, the petitioner filed a representation dated 09.03.2026 before the respondents, for issuance of patta, pertaining the subject property, in favour of the petitioner.



However, the said representation was not at all considered by the respondents till date. Hence, this petition.

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5. In reply, the learned counsel for the respondent would submit that the petitioner's representation will be disposed of within a period of 12 weeks and hence, she requests this Court to pass appropriate orders.

6. Heard the learned counsel appearing for the petitioner as well as the respondent and also perused the entire materials available on record.

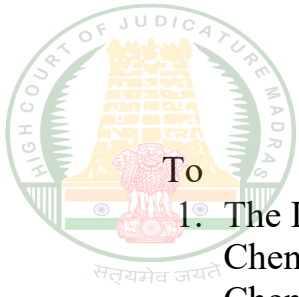
