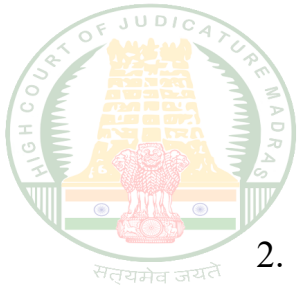

ORDER

This petition has been filed seeking to relax the condition imposed on the petitioner in Crl.O.P.No.12556 of 2026 order dated 14.05.2026 viz., the petitioner shall report before the respondent police daily at 06.30 p.m., until further orders.



C.KUMARAPPAN, J.

2. The learned Government Advocate (Crl.Side) appearing for the respondent police submitted that the petitioner has been complying with the condition regularly.

3. Considering the submissions made on either sides and the nature of the offence, this Court is inclined to modify the condition imposed in Crl.O.P.No.12556 of 2026 dated 14.05.2026. Accordingly, the condition that “the petitioner shall report before the respondent police daily at 06.30 p.m., until further orders” is modified to the effect that ***“the petitioner shall report before the respondent police on the first Monday of every month at 10.30 a.m., until further orders.”*** The other conditions imposed earlier shall remain unaltered.

4. Accordingly, this criminal miscellaneous petition is ordered.
