Prayer: Writ Petition is filed under Article 226 of Constitution of India, to issue Writ of Mandamus, directing the 2nd respondent to issue Community Certificate to the petitioner's daughters (G.Deebhana) and son (G.Sriashish) based on mother's origin.

**ORDER**

(Order of the Court was made by G.Jayachandran J.)

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The petitioner herein, based on her origin has applied for issuance of community certificates to her daughter, G.Deebhana, and son, Sriashish. The representation dated 02.06.2026, received by the Tahsildar, Taluk Office, Puducherry, on 09.06.2026, alleges that her representation has not been considered. Hence, the present writ petition has been filed.

2. In the affidavit, it is contended that the petitioner's forefathers were residents prior to the crucial date of 05.03.1964. However, her husband does not possess the necessary proof of origin in Puducherry. Therefore, she has approached this Court by way of mandamus, based on her origin.

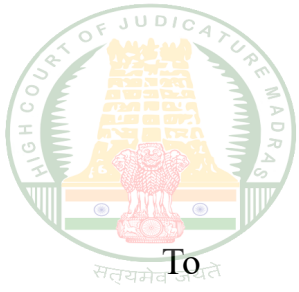

The Learned Additional Government Pleader appearing for the respondents submitted that the applications made by the petitioner are under consideration in the light of the Presidential Order dated 05.03.1964; the subsequent Circulars and Official Memorandums issued from time to time. Based on the judicial pronouncements rendered so far, necessary decision will be taken on her applications in accordance with law.



4. Recording the above submission, this Writ Petition is disposed of with a direction to the 2nd respondent to consider the representation and pass appropriate orders in accordance with law, within a period of eight weeks from the date of receipt of copy of this order. There shall be no order as to costs.
