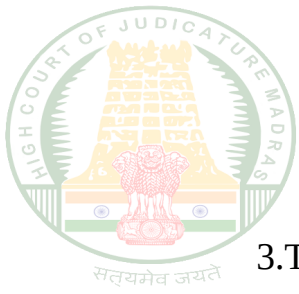

ORDER

The petitioner, who was arrested and remanded to judicial custody on
12.05.2026 for the alleged offences under Sections 8 (b) and 20 (a) (i) of the
Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substance Act, in Crime No.127 of 2026 on
the file of the respondent police, seeks bail.

2. The case of the prosecution is that the petitioner was cultivating 5
Ganja saplings in his house and subsequently 50grams of Ganja was recovered
from him. Hence, the case.



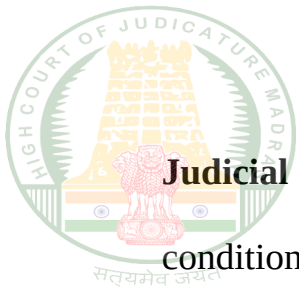
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3.The learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that the petitioner is innocent and has been in custody since 12.05.2026. He further submitted that he is ready to abide by any stringent condition that may be imposed by this Court and he is ready to co-operate for investigation. Hence, he prays for the grant of bail to the petitioner.

4.The learned Government Advocate (Criminal Side) appearing for the respondent police submitted that 50g of Ganja, which constitutes a small quantity, was recovered from the petitioner's residence. He further submitted that the petitioner has no criminal antecedents. However, he opposed for grant of bail to the petitioner.

5.Taking into consideration that the petitioner has no previous case, that the contraband recovered constitutes a small quantity (50 g of Ganja), and that the petitioner has been incarcerated since 12.05.2026, this court is of the firm view that his further custody is not necessary. Consequently, this Court is inclined to grant bail to the petitioner with certain conditions.

6. Accordingly, the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his executing a bond for a sum of Rs.25,000/- (Rupees Twenty Five Thousand only), with two sureties each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the learned



Judicial Magistrate No.II, Dharmapuri, and subject to the following conditions:

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[a] the sureties shall affix their photographs and Left Thumb Impression in the Application for Surety ship [Judicial Form No.46 annexed to 'The Criminal Rules of Practice, 2019']. The learned Magistrate shall obtain a copy of any one of the identity proofs to ensure their identity;

[b] the petitioner shall report before the respondent police daily morning at 10.30 AM for a period of fifteen days; thereafter as and when required for interrogation;

[c] the petitioner shall not abscond either during investigation or trial;

[d] the petitioner shall not tamper with the evidence or witness either during investigation or trial;

[e] on breach of any of the aforementioned conditions, the learned Magistrate/Trial Court is entitled to take appropriate action against the petitioner in accordance with law as if the conditions had been imposed and the petitioner released on bail by the learned Magistrate/Trial Court itself, as laid down by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in ***P.K.Shaji vs. State of Kerala [(2005)13 SCC 283]***;

[f] if the petitioner thereafter abscond, a fresh FIR may be registered under Section 269 of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023.
