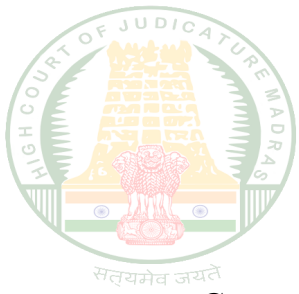

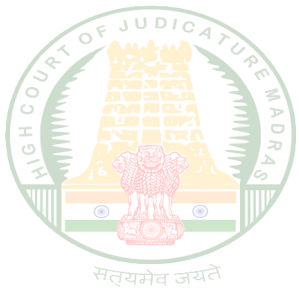

ORDER

This Criminal Original Petition has been filed seeking direction to the learned Principal District and Sessions Judge, Special Court under SC & ST Act Atrocities Act at Perambalur, to accept the surrender of the petitioners in Crime No.240 of 2026 on the file of the Special Sub Inspector of Police, Mangalamedu Police Station, Perambalur and to consider the bail petition on the same day itself.

2. The prayer sought for in this Criminal Original Petition is innocuous in nature, and as such, this petition is disposed of at the admission stage itself, without ordering notice to the third respondent.



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3. Considering the nature of accusations made and the gravity of allegations contained therein, this Court directs the petitioners to serve advance notice of the surrender petitions on the prosecution as well as on the third respondent. The respondent Police shall ensure due service of the said notice on the third respondent. Thereafter, the petitioners are at liberty to file their surrender petitions along with the bail applications and the same shall be taken up, considered and orders be passed by the learned Principal District and Sessions Judge, Special Court under SC & ST Act Atrocities Act at Perambalur, on merits on the same day of their surrender.

4. Accordingly, the Criminal Original Petition stands allowed.
