4.The 1st petitioner would mainly aver that on account of the accident that took place on 27.08.2019, she has lost her husband and in order to mobilize necessary funds towards litigation expenses, a delay of 386 days occurred.

5.Accepting the reasons stated in the affidavit, this petition is ordered on the condition that the interest for the delay period shall stand waived.
