3.Despite the receipt of notice and name of the 1<sup>st</sup> respondent having been printed in the cause list, the 1<sup>st</sup> respondent neither appeared nor entered appearance through his counsel.

4.The 1<sup>st</sup> petitioner would aver that on account of the accident that was occurred on 26.11.2017, her husband Ponnusamy passed away, and she is not in a position to mobilize funds for the litigation expenses, hence a delay of 786 days occurred in preferring the above appeal.
