



This case came up for settlement before the National Lok Adalat. Both the parties are present. Mr.U.Chithambaram, learned counsel for the appellants and Mr.D.Bhaskaran,

learned counsel for 2nd respondent/Insurance Company are present. After mutual discussion, negotiation, mediation and conciliation between both parties, they arrived at a compromise to settle the matter as follows:

TERMS OF SETTLEMENT

The appellant has preferred this Civil Miscellaneous Appeal seeking to enhance the Award dated 18.03.2025 in M.C.O.P.No.3906 of 2015 passed by the Motor Accidents Claims Tribunal, Special Sub Court I, Court of Small Causes, Chennai).

2. The Tribunal has passed an award of Rs.7,33,400/- with interest at the rate of 7.5% per annum from the date of petition till the date of deposit along with cost.

3. The parties are present along with their respective counsels. The appellant has preferred the present Civil Miscellaneous Appeal for enhancement of award amount.

4. After great deliberation and discussion, both the parties have agreed for enhancement of award amount with further additional sum of Rs.1,00,000/- (Rupees One Lakh



Only) over and above as full quit (inclusive of interest).

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5. In view of the compromise arrived at between the parties, the National Lok Adalat hereby declare and decree that the 2nd respondent/Insurance Company shall deposit the enhanced award amount of Rs.1,00,000/- (Rupees One Lakh Only) in full quit (inclusive of interest), within a period of six weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this award. On such deposit, the appellant is permitted to withdraw the enhanced award amount immediately, without filing any formal petition, before the competent Court.

6. The Tribunal is directed to issue the cheques to the parties concerned on proper identification in accordance with the terms of the award, without insisting on any formal permission petition. The Civil Miscellaneous Appeal is disposed of accordingly.
