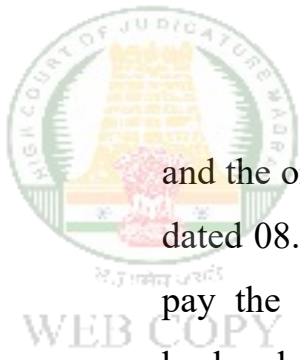

and the order passed by the 4th respondent by way of G.O (D) No.119 MAWSS dated 08.03.2013 and consequently to direct the 3rd respondent to sanction and pay the Family pension and arrears from the date of death of petitioner's husband within the prescribed time limit without reference to the communication of the 3rd respondent dated 17.03.2015 issued in Na.Ka No. 7207/Phe.O.Sa(2)/2014 with exemplary cost for causing abnormal wilful delay.

7207/Phe.O.Sa(2)/2014 with exemplary cost for causing abnormal wilful delay.

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2. The learned Standing Counsel for second respondent would submit that the grievance of petitioner stands redressed and would furnish a copy of the instructions.
