**ORDER**

This writ petition has been filed to direct the 1<sup>st</sup> & 2<sup>nd</sup> respondent to consider the petitioner's representation dated 04.08.2022.

2. The learned counsel for the petitioner would submit that in this case, the petitioner has given a representation dated 04.08.2022 requesting the 1<sup>st</sup> & 2<sup>nd</sup> respondents to de-freeze the petitioner's account.
