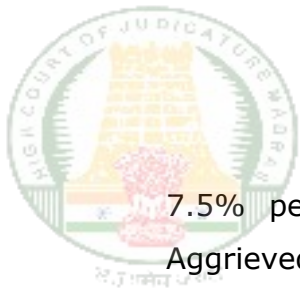

This case is taken up for settlement before the National Lok Adalat. Both the parties are present. Mr.C. Bhuvanasundari, learned counsel for the Appellant/ Insurance Company and Mr. R. Rajarajan, learned counsel for the respondents 1 to 3 are present. After mutual discussion, negotiation, mediation and conciliation between both parties, they arrived at a compromise to settle the matter as follows:

TERMS OF SETTLEMENT

The Tribunal has awarded a sum of Rs.16,35,369/-, with interest at



7.5% per annum, from the date of petition till the date of realization. Aggrieved by the award of the Tribunal, the appellant/ insurance company preferred the present appeal. It is stated that the appellant/ insurance company had already deposited amount of Rs.15,96,648/- to the credit of M.C.O.P.No.590 of 2017 on the file of the Motor Accident Claims Tribunal, Special Sub Court, Coimbatore.

2. After due deliberation and consultation, both the parties have agreed to settle the award to a sum of Rs.5,00,000/- (Rupees Five Lakhs Only) over and above the amount awarded by the Tribunal, as full quit compensation, inclusive of the interest.

3. Hence, the appellant/ insurance company is directed to deposit the enhanced amount of Rs.5,00,000/- (Rupees Five Lakhs Only), arrived today, within a period of six weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order, to the credit of M.C.O.P.No.590 of 2017 on the file of the Motor Accident Claims Tribunal, Special Sub Court, Coimbatore and on such deposit, the respondents 1 to 3/ claimants are directed to withdraw the same and the amount already deposited by the insurance company with accrued interest, as per the apportionment stated below.

5. The Tribunal is directed to transfer the above said award amount to the Bank accounts of the appellants/ claimants by way of NEFT / RTGS, on proper identification, in accordance with the terms of the award, without insisting on any formal permission petition.

6. The Civil Miscellaneous Appeal is disposed of accordingly. No costs. Consequently, connected civil miscellaneous petition, if any is closed.
