JOINT MEMO FOR RECORDING SETTLEMENT

1. The appeal has been filed by the appellant/Petitioner. The above MCOP has been filed claiming compensation for injuries sustained by the Appellant/Petitioner in motor accident dated 19.01.2013 by the vehicle owned by the 1st Respondent and insured with the 2nd Respondent herein.

2. The tribunal passed award dated 12.07.2022 for sum of Rs.2,33,600/- along with interest & Costs. The said amount already



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been deposited by the 2nd Respondent and the same already been withdrawn by the Appellant/petitioner.

3. The Appellant/Petitioner filed this present appeal for the purpose of enhancement of compensation awarded in aforesaid MCOP dated 12.07.2022. Being that, the Appellant/Petitioner have negotiated for settlement and arrived at a sum of Rs.3,25,000/- (Three Lakhs and Twenty Five Thousand only) in full quit.
4. The both Appellant/Petitioner and 2nd Respondent/Insurance Co. is amicably willing to settle this present appeal for the sum Rs.3,25,000/- (Three Lakhs and Twenty Five Thousand only) in full quit. Further, the 2nd Respondent also agreed to deposit the aforementioned amount to the credit of the above MCOP within 6 weeks from the date of receipt of the award passed on the basis of this joint memo. On such deposit being made, the Appellant/Claimant is permitted to withdraw the entire settlement amount after filing proper petition for withdrawal.
5. It is prayed that this Hon'ble High Court may be pleased to record this Memo of Compromise and pass award for Rs.3,25,000/- (Three Lakhs and Twenty Five Thousand rupees only) full quit in Favor of the Appellant/Claimant payable by the 2nd Respondent/Insurance Company to the credit of the above MCOP within a period of 6 weeks from date of receipt of the copy of the award and render justice.
