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SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT

PARTY OF THE SECOND PART (which expression shall,
unless repugnant to the context, mean and include his
heirs, executors, administrators and assigns), of the Other
Part,

WHEREAS the party of second part has lodged police complaint
as against the party of first part and his family members and the said
complaint has been registered on 05.10.2025 in Cr.No.1/2025 for the
offences U/s 376(1), 313, 323 r/w 109 IPC on the file of the All Women
Police Station, Coimbatore South,

WHEREAS the party of the first part and his family members
moved an Anticipatory bail petition before this Honble Court in
Crl.OP.No.28636 and 28637 of 2025. At the time of Hearing of the

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case, at the consent of both the parties it was referred to Mediation. In the Mediation the party of the second part agreed to receive a sum of Rs.19,00,000/- from the party of the first part towards final settlement of the issue.

AND WHEREAS the parties hereto have worked out the terms and conditions of their compromise and also decided to reduce the same into writing;

NOW, THIS COMPROMISE MEMO WITNESSES, as follows

1. That the parties hereto do hereby declare and confirm that the Memorandum of Compromise under these presents does not amount to any collusion on their part, and they do hereby further and once again declare and confirm that they sincerely enter into and execute this memorandum of compromise only with their full consent and final agreement.

2. That the Party of the First Part in order to give quietus to the issue shall pay a sum of Rs.19,00,000/- (Rupees Nineteen Lakhs only) to the Party of the Second Part in the following manner :

a) Rs.10,00,000/- by way of Demand Draft dated 20.3.2026 bearing No. 003737 drawn on IDBI Bank, Coimbatore Branch.

b) Rs.9,00,000/- by way of Demand Draft dated 20.3.2026 bearing No. 003738 drawn on IDBI Bank, Coimbatore Branch to the Party of the Second Part.





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3. That the party of the second part shall withdraw the complaint as against the party of the first part and his family member viz (i) Mrs. Gnanammal (ii) Mr. Narasimma Moorthy (iii) Mrs. Sonia and (iv) Mr. Dhilip Kumar, registered in Cr.No. 1/2025 on the file of the All women police station, Coimbatore south

4. That the both parties have no claim as against each others
