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ORDER

(Order of the Court was made by
the Hon'ble Chief Justice)

At the outset, learned counsel for respondent submits that the order passed earlier, which led to filing of contempt petition, has been recalled by the competent authority on 09.01.2026, copy of which has been placed on record.

2. We have perused the status report, as also the order dated 09.01.2026 recalling the earlier order.

3. The affidavit of respondent records an unconditional apology. Having considered the totality of circumstances that the earlier order has now been recalled, we are not inclined to proceed further in the matter. Contempt petition is closed. Rule is discharged.

4. We will further observe that the Officer shall remain cautious and careful in future in the matter of compliance of the



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orders of the Court.

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5. In view of the recall of order, nothing survives for consideration in the petition. Petition is accordingly, rendered infructuous.

6. Petition is disposed of as having rendered infructuous. There shall be no order as to costs. Consequently, the interim application is closed.
