No prejudice would be caused to any of the respondents, if the petitioner's representation as stated supra is considered on merits and in accordance with law, after hearing the objections of the respondents 5 to 8 as well as any other third party, whom the 2nd respondent deems it fit to enquire, within a time frame to be fixed by this Court.

5. This Court is not expressing any opinion on the merits of the petitioner's representation.

6. For the foregoing reasons, this Court directs the 2nd respondent to pass final orders on merits and in accordance with law, on the petitioner's representation, dated 14.09.2025 seeking for cancellation of patta standing in the name of the respondents 5 to 8 for the property morefully described in the prayer to this writ petition, within a period of

twelve (12) weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order, after hearing the objections, if any from the respondents 5 to 8, and any other third party, whom the 2nd respondent deems it fit to enquire.
