2. It is the specific submission of the learned counsel for the petitioner that the 3rd respondent has encroached upon the petitioner's land so as to put up a storm water drainage.

3. However, it is the submission of the learned Special Government Pleader that such construction is made only in the Government land.

4. Therefore, it is found from the either side submission that there are disputed facts in respect of the title over the property. In a Writ jurisdiction this Court cannot go into the disputed facts.

5. Therefore, we do not find any ground to entertain the present Writ Petition. Accordingly, granting liberty to the petitioner to approach the competent civil Court of law, this present Writ Petition is **dismissed**. No costs.
