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ORDER

The present application has been filed for cancellation of the order of anticipatory bail granted in favour of respondents 1 and 2 / accused in Crl.O.P.No.15148 of 2025 dated 16.05.2025.

2. During the pendency of the application, the matter was referred to the Tamil Nadu Mediation and Conciliation Centre, High Court, Madras, and a Settlement Agreement was entered into between the parties on 05.02.2026 before the Mediation Centre. The terms of the Settlement Agreement are as follows:

**NOW THIS DEED OF AGREEMENT OF COMPROMISE WITNESSETH
AS FOLLOWS: -**

1. That the party of first part and second part shall file a petition under section 13(B) of the Hindu marriage Act, at Family Court, Chennai.
2. That the party of the first part offers to give a sum of Rs.22,00,000 (Rs. Twenty-Two Lakhs Only) in lieu of permanent alimony to sever



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the matrimonial tie and party of the second part has accepted for receiving the said consideration on her own volition free from any influence to sever the matrimonial tie between party of the first part and second part.

3. That the party of the first part also agrees and undertakes to give the above said payment by Demand drafts, the payment shall be made in the following manner: ₹ 5,00,000 /- at the time of filing of mutual consent divorce petition; ₹ 6,00,000 /- at the time of Quash petition, ₹11,00,000 /- at the time of finalizing decree of divorce/recording evidence in the Mutual consent petition.
4. That no dispute survives between the parties with regard to the Gold Jewels.
5. That the party of the First part agrees to give back the Wooden Cot, Mattress and Cupboard to the party of the second part allowing their person to collect it from the First party's house before recording evidence in the Mutual consent petition
6. Both parties agrees to cooperate for withdrawal, disposal or quashing of all pending civil, criminal, matrimonial and ancillary proceedings arising out of the marriage, in accordance with law.
7. Neither both parties shall hereafter not to initiate, institute, file, prosecute or cause to be initiated any civil, criminal, matrimonial, quasi-judicial or other proceedings, complaints, FIRs, petitions, representations or claims of any nature whatsoever against the other

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party, their family members or relatives, in respect of the matrimonial relationship or any matter arising therefrom

8. The party of the second part shall have no right of claiming any further amount in the form of maintenance following divorce to be decreed, severing the matrimonial tie. Thereafter the party of the first part and second part shall have no claim against each other in the past, present and in future.

This settlement Agreement is executed in three (3) copies, each of which shall have the same legal force and effect as the original, and together shall constitute one and the same instrument.
