PRAYER:

Writ Petition filed under Section 226 of the Constitution of India, seeking to issue a Writ of Mandamus, directing the respondent herein to settle the difference in Medical Leave salary to the petitioners 1 to 19 herein with 6 percentage interest in view of G.O.(Ms)No.220, Transport (C1) Department dated 06.08.1999 and in the light of the orders passed by this Hon'ble Court in W.P.(MD)No.14520 of 2020 dated 21.03.2023, W.P.No.29602, 29604, 29606 and 29609 of 2023 dated 12.10.2023 and by considering the representation of the petitioners herein on 10.10.2025 by the 1st petitioner herein, on 25.06.2025 by the 2nd petitioner herein, on 19.10.2024 by the 3rd petitioner herein, on 28.07.2025 by the 4th petitioner herein, on 26.04.2025 by the 5th petitioner herein, on 25.04.2025 by the 6th petitioner herein, on 18.08.2025 by the 7th



petitioner herein, on 03.09.2025 by the 8th petitioner herein, on 05.07.2025 by the 9th petitioner herein, on 06.11.2025 by the 10th petitioner herein, on 10.11.2025 by the 11th petitioner herein, on 10.11.2025 by the 12th petitioner herein, on 06.11.2025 by the 13th petitioner herein, on 12.11.2025 by the 14th petitioner herein, on 11.11.2025 by the 15th petitioner herein, on 15.10.2025 by the 16th petitioner herein, on 24.11.2025 by the 17th petitioner herein, on 17.11.2025 by the 18th petitioner herein and on 17.11.2025 by the 19th petitioner herein.

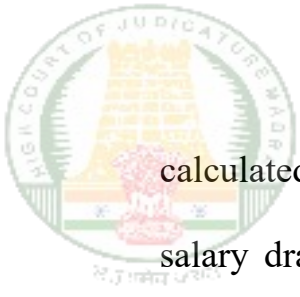

ORDER

This Writ Petition has been filed seeking to consider the representations of the petitioner to settle the difference in their Medical Leave as per G.O. (Ms).No.220, Transport (C1) Department dated 06.08.1999 and in the light of the orders passed by this Hon'ble Court in W.P.(MD)No.14520 of 2020 dated 21.03.2023, W.P.No.29602, 29604, 29606 and 29609 of 2023 dated 12.10.2023.

2. Mr.R.balaji, learned counsel takes notice on behalf of the respondent herein.

3. It is the case of the petitioners that they were employed under the respondent Transport Corporation and that their medical leave salary was



calculated based on the basic pay drawn to them on 01.09.1998, instead of the salary drawn at the time of their retirement. Therefore, the petitioners herein made representations dated 10.10.2025, 25.06.2025, 19.10.2024, 28.07.2025, 26.04.2025, 25.04.2025, 18.08.2025, 03.09.2025, 05.07.2025, 06.11.2025, 10.11.2025, 10.11.2025, 06.11.2025, 12.11.2025, 11.11.2025, 15.10.2025, 24.11.2025, 17.11.2025 and 17.11.2025 before the respondent, seeking payment of the difference in medical leave salary in accordance with G.O.(Ms)No.220, Transport (C1) Department dated 06.08.1999. However, the said representations have not been considered till date and therefore, the present Writ Petition has been filed.

4. Learned Counsel appearing for the petitioner submits that it would suffice, if this Court issues a direction to the respondent to consider the representations of the petitioners and pass appropriate orders on the same within the time that may be stipulated by this Court.

5. On the above contention, this Court heard the learned counsel appearing for the respondent.

6. In view of the limited relief sought for by the petitioners, this Court without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, directs the respondent to consider the petitioners' representations dated 10.10.2025,

7. This Writ Petition stands disposed of with the aforesaid direction.

There shall be no order as to costs.
