ORDER

The petitioner herein apprehends arrest at the hands of the respondent police for the offences punishable under Sections 303(2), 326(a), 21(1) of BNS, in Crime No.152 of 2025, on the file of the respondent Police, seeks anticipatory bail.

It is seen that, petitioner's earlier anticipatory bail petition was dismissed on merits on 05.11.2025 in Crl.O.P.No.30017 of 2025 and now, the learned Government Advocate (Crl.
