Writ Appeal filed under Clause 15 of the Letters Patent, praying to set aside the order dated 10.10.2025 made in W.P.No.2864 of 2021.

For Appellant : Mr.C.Harish



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directed the Labour Court to consider the additional documents produced by the first respondent, afford due opportunity to all parties and pass appropriate orders on merits and in accordance with law and a timeline of three months was also fixed for disposal of the petition.

5. The learned counsel for the appellant would mainly contend that additional documents filed by the first respondent workman are forged documents and that the genuineness of such documents can be tested only during the course of trial. He would submit that forming even a *prima facie* opinion about the documents is unnecessary and therefore, the writ Court directed the Labour Court to test the genuineness of additional documents filed by the first respondent workman.

6. Thus, this Court does not find any infirmity or perversity in the order passed by the writ Court and therefore, the present Writ Appeal is devoid of merits and the same stands dismissed. There shall be no order as to costs.
