For the foregoing reasons, this writ petition is disposed of by directing the first respondent to pass final orders, on merits and in accordance with law on the petitioner's revision petition dated 08.02.2024, after hearing the objections of the respondents 4 and 5 and any other third party whom the first respondent deems it fit to enquire and by adhering to the principles of natural justice within a period of 12 weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.
