Prayer : Writ Petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, for issuance of a Writ of Mandamus directing the first and fourth respondents to survey and demarcate the boundaries of the petitioner's land (Patta No.2796) in Survey No.68/2D1 in Pilaviduthi Village, Karambakkudi Taluk, Pudukkottai District, based on her Application dated 06.01.2025, within time stipulated by this Court and further



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directing the second and third respondents to provide protection during the survey, if required.

ORDER

This Writ Petition has been filed seeking issuance of a Writ of Mandamus directing the first and fourth respondents to survey and demarcate the boundaries of the petitioner's land in Patta No.2796, comprised in Survey No.68/2D1, situated at Pilaviduthi Village, Karambakkudi Taluk, Pudukkottai District, based on her application dated 06.01.2025, within a time frame to be stipulated by this Court and further directing the second and third respondents to provide protection during the survey, if required.

2. With the consent of the parties, this Writ Petition is taken up for final disposal at the admission stage itself.



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3. The learned counsel appearing for the petitioner would submit that an application has been submitted for the survey of the property in question and for demarcation of its boundaries.

4. The learned Additional Government Pleader appearing for the first and fourth respondents, on instructions, would submit that after consideration of the claims of the parties, proper steps would be taken to survey and demarcate the land in question in accordance with Sections 9 and 10 of the Tamil Nadu Land Survey and Boundaries Act, 1923.

5. Recording the aforesaid submissions, this Court directs the first and fourth respondents to consider the application of the petitioner dated 06.01.2025, survey and demarcate the petitioner's land after consideration of the claims of all parties including and pass orders in accordance with Sections 9 and 10 of the Tamil Nadu Land Survey and Boundaries Act, 1923, within a period of twelve weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order. In the event of any rival claims, the parties are at liberty to pursue their remedies before the Civil Court. It is needless to state that before surveying the land, notice shall be issued to the adjacent



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landowners and other interested parties and that if required, police assistant may be taken.

6. With the above directions, this Writ Petition stands disposed of.

There shall be no order as to costs.
