ORDER

This Civil Revision Petition has been filed to direct the learned Additional District Judge, Fast Track Court, Palani, to dispose of the suit in O.S.No.355 of 2025 at the earliest.

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2. Heard Mr.Karthikeyan for Mr.R.Velmurugan learned Counsel for the petitioner and Mr.M.Prabhakaran, learned Counsel for the respondents.

3. Today, when the matter is taken up for hearing, it is informed by both the learned counsel for the petitioner as well as learned counsel for the respondents that during the pendency of this Civil Revision Petition, a Joint Memo of Compromise, dated 08.01.2026, has been filed by the petitioner and the respondents stating that the dispute has been amicably settled between them. In the Joint Memo of Compromise dated 08.01.2026, it had been stated as under:

1. The above suit has been filed for the relief of recovery of money to the tune of Rs.20,00,000/- with interest and cost.
2. In I.A.387 of 2025, an attachment has also been made by the Learned Additional District Court (Fast Track Court), Palani.
3. Pending the suit, at the intervention of the wellwishers and mutual friends, an amicable settlement has been arrived at between the parties.
4. According to the amicable settlement, all the loan dues claimed by the plaintiff is settled by 2nd defendants namely



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Balaarun and Pranav vide cheques bearing Nos.000721 & 000381 drawn at **ICICI Bank, Palani Branch** on **30.12.2025** with the condition that suit has to be closed based on this out of court settlement and the attachment in I.A.No.387 of 2025 made on their property has to be raised forthwith.

5. In view of the above settlement, Petitioner/Plaintiff hereby submits his no objection for closing the suit and raising the attachment in I.A.No.387 of 2025 based on the above out of court settlement.

It is therefore humbly prayed that this Hon'ble Court may be pleased to accept this memo and close the suit in O.S.No.355 of 2025 and raise the attachment in I.A.No. 387 of 2025 on the file of Learned Additional District Court (Fast Track Court), Palani and pass such further or other orders as this Hon'ble Court feels appropriate and thus render justice.
