PRAYER: Writ Petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, to issue a Writ of Mandamus, directing the first respondent to conduct survey and demarcation of the petitioner's land comprised in S.F.No.186/1B2 to an extent of 60 Square Feet situated at Valaiyankulam Village, Thirupparankundram Taluk, Madurai District along with necessary police protection.

ORDER

The writ petition has been filed seeking issuance of a Writ of Mandamus, directing the first respondent to conduct survey and demarcation of the petitioner's land comprised in S.F.No.186/1B2 to an extent of 60 Square Feet, situated at Valaiyankulam Village, Thirupparankundram Taluk, Madurai District along with necessary police protection.

2. By consent, the Writ Petition is taken up for final disposal at the admission stage itself.

3. The learned counsel appearing for the petitioner would submit that the petitioner is the absolute owner of the property in question and that the application seeking survey and demarcation of its boundaries is pending without any progress.

4. The learned Additional Government Pleader appearing for the first respondent would submit that proper steps would be taken to survey and



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demarcate the land in accordance with Sections 9 and 10 of the Tamil Nadu Survey and Boundaries Act, 1923.

5. Recording the aforesaid submission, this Court directs the first respondent to consider the petitioner's representation dated 19.09.2025 and demarcate the petitioner's land, after considering the claims of the petitioner and any other rival parties, if any, and to pass orders in accordance with Sections 9 and 10 of the Tamil Nadu Survey and Boundaries Act, 1923, within a period of fourteen weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order. Needless to state that in the event of any rival claims, the parties are at liberty to work out their remedies before the Civil Court.

6. With the above direction, this Writ Petition is disposed of. There shall be no order as to costs.
