ORDER

2. According to the learned Standing Counsel appearing for the respondent Bank, the petitioner has to produce records to establish that she is employed in Trichirappalli. Only then the request of the petitioner could be considered by the Bank for disbursement of the education loan.

The third respondent Bank is directed to consider the request of the petitioner and pass orders as per norms within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt of documents from the writ petitioner.
