ORDER

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(1)The present petition is filed by the petitioner seeking relaxation of the condition imposed by this Court vide order dated 16.12.2025 in Crl.MP.(MD).No.19907/2025 in Crl.A.(MD).No.1196/2025.

(3)Considering the fact that the petitioner is complying with the conditional order dated 16.12.2025, till date, this Court is of the view that the condition imposed on the petitioner, be modified.

(4)Accordingly, the petition is **ordered** and the petitioner is directed to report before the Inspector of Police, All Women Police Station, Andipatti, on every alternate Monday of the English Calendar month at 10.30 a.m., until further orders.
