3.The learned Counsel for the petitioner would submit that the petitioner has already sent a representation to the respondents 1 & 2 on 17.07.2025 with regard to the alleged grievance of misappropriation of funds by the respondents 5 to 8. Since the said representation remain unconsidered, the petitioner has come up with the present Writ Petition.

4.Learned Counsel appearing for the respondents 1 to 4 would submit that the representation of the petitioner would be considered by the respondents 1 & 2 in accordance with law, within a time frame to be fixed by this Court.

5.Accordingly, this Writ Petition is disposed of, by directing the respondents 1 & 2 to consider the petitioner's representation dated 17.07.2025, by following the procedure under Section 70 of the Wakf Act and pass orders on merits and in accordance with law, within a period of four [4] weeks from the date of receipt of a copy
