Prayer : Writ Petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, for issuance of a Writ of Mandamus directing the first and second respondents herein to conduct survey and demarcate four boundaries in respect of the property comprised in S.No.470/21 situated at Kunnakudi Revenue Village, Thirupathur Taluk, Sivagangai District with the aid of the third respondent and further directing the first and second respondents to issue survey report on the basis of the application dated 05.11.2025 and the consequential representation dated 20.12.2025, in accordance with law, within a stipulated time period.

ORDER

This Writ Petition has been filed seeking issuance of a Writ of Mandamus directing the first and second respondents to conduct a survey and demarcate the boundaries in respect of the property comprised in S.No.470/21, situated at Kunnakudi Revenue Village, Thirupathur Taluk, Sivagangai District, with the assistance of the third respondent and further to issue a survey report based on the application dated 05.11.2025 and the consequential representation dated 20.12.2025, in accordance with law, within a stipulated time to be fixed by this Court.

2. With the consent of the parties, this Writ Petition is taken up for final disposal at the admission stage itself.

3. The learned counsel appearing for the petitioner would submit that an online application has been submitted for the survey of the property in question and for demarcation of its boundaries.

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4. The learned Additional Government Pleader appearing for the first and second respondents would submit that after consideration of the claims of the parties, proper steps would be taken to survey and demarcate the land in question in accordance with Sections 9 and 10 of the Tamil Nadu Land Survey and Boundaries Act, 1923.

5. Recording the aforesaid submissions, this Court directs the first and second respondents to consider the online application of the petitioner dated 05.11.2025, survey and demarcate the petitioner's land after consideration of the claims of all parties and pass orders in accordance with Sections 9 and 10 of the Tamil Nadu Land Survey and Boundaries Act, 1923, within a period of sixteen weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order. In the event of any rival claims, the parties are at liberty to pursue their remedies before the Civil Court. It is needless to state that before surveying the land, notice shall be issued to the adjacent landowners and other interested parties, if any and that if required, police assistance may be taken.
