PRAYER: Writ Petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, to issue a Writ of Certiorarified Mandamus, calling for the records on the file of the first respondent in connection with the impugned order of rejection passed by him in Na.Ka.No.JP22/2025/S dated 02.12.2025 and quash the same as illegal and



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arbitrary and consequently direct the first respondent to conduct an enquiry with the respondents 3 to 5 and other interested parties of R.S.No.15 of Kathakinaru Village, Thamaraipatti, Madurai East Taluk, Madurai District and thereby conduct a survey and fix boundaries of the petitioner's property to an extent of 17 cents situated in R.S.No.15 (Patta No.55) of Kadhakinaru Village based on the petitioner's father's registered sale deed in Document No.1472 of 1960 dated 26.06.1960, on the file of the Sub-Registrar, Thamaraipatti of Madurai District, within the time limit that may be stipulated by this Court.

ORDER
