ORDER : The Court made the following order :-

The petitioner, who was arrested and remanded to
judicial custody on 28.12.2025 for the offences

punishable under Sections 11(1) r/w 12 of POCSO Act, and 351(2) of BNS, 2023, in Crime No.106 of 2025, on the file of the respondent police, seeks bail.

2. The case of the prosecution is that the petitioner has shown his private parts and vulgar sign to the victim girl, who is studying 7th standard, and has given Rs.100/- and insisted her to come to the backyard. Hence, the complaint.

3. The learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that the petitioner is an innocent person and he has not committed any offences as alleged by the prosecution. He further submitted that already there is a family dispute between the two families due to which they lodged a false complaint against the petitioner. He further submitted that the petitioner is in judicial custody from 28.12.2025. Hence, he seeks bail to the petitioner.

4. The learned Additional Public Prosecutor submitted that the petitioner is the neighbour of the

victim girl, hence, stringent conditions may be imposed. He further submitted that the trial is commenced. However, he opposed for grant of bail to the petitioner.

5. Taking into consideration of the facts and circumstances of the case and the fact that the trial is commenced and also considering the period of incarceration suffered by the petitioner, this Court is inclined to grant bail to the petitioner, subject to the following conditions:

6. Accordingly, the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on executing a bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand only) with two sureties, each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the learned the Sessions Judge, Special Court for POCSO Act Cases, Srivilliputhur, Virudhuangar District and on further conditions that :-

[a] the petitioner and the sureties shall affix their photographs and left thumb impression in the surety bond and the

Magistrate may obtain a copy of their Aadhaar card or bank pass book to ensure their identity;

[b] the petitioner shall report before the trial Court for all hearing dates, otherwise; otherwise the petitioner is directed to stay at Madurai and he shall not intimidate the victim girl or her family and shall not enter into the street, school, house, college or other places where normally the victim is available;

[c] the petitioner shall not tamper with the evidence or witness either during investigation or trial;

[d] the petitioner shall not abscond either during investigation or trial;

[e] On breach of any of the aforesaid conditions, the learned Magistrate/Trial Court is entitled to take appropriate action against the petitioner in accordance with law as if the conditions

have been imposed and the petitioner is released on bail by the learned Magistrate/Trial Court himself as laid down by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in P.K.Shaji vs. State of Kerala [(2005)AIR SCW 5560];

[f] If the accused thereafter absconds, a fresh FIR can be registered under Section 269 BNS.
