This writ petition has been filed as a public interest litigation seeking a writ of mandamus directing the authorities concerned to conduct a Special Camp for issuance of birth certificates to the students.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner states that some tribal students studying in the schools have no birth certificates and therefore, they

In such circumstances, we are not inclined to entertain this public interest litigation of this nature, without even a request was made by the students for issuance of birth certificates.
