This Court without expressing any opinion on merits of the claim made by the petitioner direct the respondents to consider the petitioner's representations dated 24.01.2026 and pass appropriate orders on its own merits and in accordance with law within a period of two weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order. Further the petitioner is also directed to co-operate with the enquiry.

4. With the above direction, the Writ Petition is disposed of. No Costs.
