ORDER

The petitioner, who apprehends arrest at the hands of the respondent police for the offences punishable under Sections 91(2), 191(3), 296(6), 351(3) of BNS Act, 2023 and Section 3 of TNPPDL Act, 1992, seeks anticipatory bail.

2. The case of the prosecution is that the accused persons have attacked the defacto complainant with Aruval and bike was also damaged. Hence, the complaint.

3. The learned counsel appearing for the petitioner submitted that the petitioner is an innocent person and he is no way connected with the alleged occurrence as stated by the prosecution. He further submitted that the petitioner is ready and willing to abide by any conditions that may be imposed by this Court. Hence, he seeks anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

4. The learned Government Advocate (Criminal Side) appearing for the respondent Police opposed to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner on the ground that the damage is quantified as Rs.600/- and totally there are five previous cases pending against the petitioner. He further submitted that no injury was caused by the petitioner.

5. Considering the facts of the case and also considering the fact that no injury was caused, this Court is inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner, with certain conditions.

6. Accordingly, the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail in the event of arrest or on his appearance, on condition that the petitioner shall execute a bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand only) with two sureties each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the Judicial Magistrate Court, Ambasamudram, Tirunelveli District, within a period of fifteen days from the date on which the order copy made ready on further conditions that:

[a]the petitioners and the sureties shall affix their photographs and left thumb impression in the surety bond and the Magistrate may obtain a copy of their Aadhaar card or bank pass book to ensure their identity.

[b] the petitioner is directed to deposit Rs.1,000/-[Rupees Thousand only] to the credit of the Correspondent, Sethupathy Pandithurai Higher Secondary School Parent, having account in State Bank of India, Karimedu Branch, Account No.30033864969, Account

Type:Regular Savings Bank Account, CIF No:85019457624, MICR Code:625002017. This fund shall be utilized for the purpose of purchasing furniture (Benches & Desks) for newly constructed class rooms under 'Namakku Naame' Scheme, and on such deposit being made, the Judicial Magistrate shall accept the sureties furnished by the petitioners;

[c] the petitioner is directed to report before the respondent police daily morning at 10.30 a.m. and evening at 05.30 p.m., until further orders and cooperate for interrogation.

[d] the petitioner shall not tamper with the evidence or witness either during investigation or trial.

[e]the petitioner shall not abscond either during investigation or trial.

[f]On breach of any of the aforesaid conditions, the learned Magistrate/Trial Court is entitled to take appropriate action against the petitioner in accordance with law as if the conditions have been imposed and the petitioner is released on bail by the learned Magistrate/Trial Court himself as laid down by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in P.K.Shaji vs. State of Kerala [(2005)AIR SCW 5560].
