PRAYER: Writ Petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, praying this Court to issue a Writ of Mandamus, directing respondents 1 to 3, to disqualify the respondents 8 and 9 from participating in the tender process in Tender Notice No.20/2025-26/HDO dated 19.08.2025 and to cancel the tender bids submitted by the respondents 8 and 9, as they have relied upon false and misleading Working Condition of Plant and Machinery Certificates thereby failed to satisfy the mandatory eligibility conditions prescribed under the tender notice dated 19.08.2025, by violating the tender conditions and the provisions of the Tamil Nadu Transparency in Tenders Rules, 2000 by



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considering the representation of the petitioner dated 08.11.2025 and 08.01.2026.
