This Court, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the matter, directs the second respondent to forward the petitioner's representation to the Assistant Commissioner, HR & CE Department, Thiruvanaikoil, Trichirappalli District forthwith. The Assistant Commissioner is directed to consider and dispose of the same, on merits and in accordance with law, within a period of four (4) weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.

5. Accordingly, the writ petition stands disposed of. No costs.
