ORDER : The Court made the following order :-

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The petitioners, who were arrested and remanded to judicial custody on 06.12.2025 for the offences punishable under Sections 125 of BNS, 2023 and 25(1A) of Arms Act, 1959, in Crime No.310 of 2025 on the file of the respondent police, seek bail.

2. The case of the prosecution is that on 06.12.2025, at about 08.00 hrs, the petitioner and other accused created panic and fear among the general public by holding sword near the backside of the old Government Hospital, Udayam Nagar Division Road, Karaikudi. Hence, the complaint.

3. The learned counsel for the petitioners submitted that the petitioners are innocent person and they have not committed any offences as alleged by the prosecution. He further submitted that the petitioners are in judicial custody from 06.12.2025. Hence, he seeks bail to the petitioner.

4. The learned Additional Public Prosecutor vehemently objected that the petitioner has 20 previous cases pending against him and that he is a history sheeter. Therefore, he opposed for grant of bail to the petitioner.

5. Further in another case, this Court granted bail and directed the petitioner to report before the Kanniyakumari Police Station. However, the petitioner did not report even for a single day. The petitioner submitted that, before he proceed to Kanniyakumari, he was arrested in two other cases. Considering the facts and circumstances of the case and also considering the period of incarceration suffered by the petitioner, this Court is inclined to grant bail to the petitioner, subject to the following conditions:

6. Accordingly, the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on executing a bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand only) with two sureties, each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the learned Judicial Magistrate, Karaikudi, and on further conditions that :-

[a] the petitioner and the sureties shall affix their photographs and left thumb impression in the surety bond and the Magistrate may obtain a copy of their Aadhaar card or bank pass book to ensure their identity.

[b] the petitioner shall stay at Kanniyakumari and report before the Inspector of Police, Kanniyakumari Town Police Station, daily at 10.30 a.m., until further orders except on the trial court hearing dates. No relaxation shall be consideration for the next three months.

[c] the petitioner shall not tamper with the evidence or witness either during investigation or trial.

[d] the petitioner shall not abscond either during investigation or trial.

[e] On breach of any of the aforesaid conditions, the learned Magistrate/Trial Court is entitled to take appropriate action against the petitioner in accordance with law as if the conditions have been imposed and the petitioner is released on bail by the learned Magistrate/Trial Court himself as laid down by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in P.K.Shaji vs. State of Kerala

[f] If the accused thereafter absconds, a fresh FIR can be registered under Section 269 BNS.
