PETITION FOR BAIL Under Sec.483 of BNSS

PRAYER :-

To enlarge on bail in connection with C.C.No.81 of 2023 on the file of
the Judicial Magistrate, Bodinayakanur.

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ORDER : The Court made the following order :-

The petitioner, who was arrested and remanded to judicial custody on 27.01.2026 for the offences punishable under Sections 379 of IPC and 21(1) of Mines and Minerals (Development and Regulation) Act, 1957, in C.C.No.81 of 2023 on the file of the Judicial Magistrate, Bodinayakanur., seeks bail.

2. The case of the prosecution is that the petitioner had illegally transported river sand without a valid permission. Hence, the complaint.

3. The learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that the petitioner is an innocent person and he has not committed any offences as alleged by the prosecution. He further submitted that the petitioner is in judicial custody from 27.01.2026. Hence, he seeks bail to the petitioner.

4. The learned Additional Public Prosecutor submitted that the



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petitioner had jumped bail, and a non-bailable warrant was issued against him. Subsequently, he was arrested on 27.01.2026. Therefore, he opposed for grant of bail to the petitioner.

5. Taking into consideration of the fact that the petitioner had jumped bail and also considering the period of incarceration suffered by the petitioner, this Court is inclined to grant bail to the petitioner, subject to the following conditions:

6. Accordingly, the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on executing a bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand only) with two sureties, each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the learned Judicial Magistrate, Bodinayakanur, and on further conditions that :-

[a] the petitioner and the sureties shall affix their photographs and left thumb impression in the surety bond and the Magistrate may obtain a copy of their Aadhaar card or bank pass book to ensure their identity.

[b] the petitioner shall report before the Trial Court daily at 10.30 a.m., until further orders.



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[c] the petitioner shall not tamper with the evidence or witness either during investigation or trial.

[d] the petitioner shall not abscond either during investigation or trial.

[e] On breach of any of the aforesaid conditions, the learned Magistrate/Trial Court is entitled to take appropriate action against the petitioner in accordance with law as if the conditions have been imposed and the petitioner is released on bail by the learned Magistrate/Trial Court himself as laid down by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in P.K.Shaji vs. State of Kerala [(2005)AIR SCW 5560].

[f] If the accused thereafter absconds, a fresh FIR can be registered under Section 269 BNS.
