Prayer in CMP(MD)No.1927 of 2026 : This Civil Miscellaneous Petition filed under Section 151 of Civil Procedure Code praying to permit the petitioner to withdraw the 50% of deposited amount in M.C.O.P.No.348 of 2021 on the file of the Motor Accident Claims Tribunal (Chief Judicial Magistrate) Dindigul.

Prayer in CMA(MD)No.963 of 2025 : This Civil Miscellaneous Appeal filed under Section 173 of the Motor Vehicle Act praying to allow this appeal by set aside the order and decretal order dated 27.12.2024 made in M.C.O.P.No.348 of 2021 on the file of the Motor Accident Claim Tribunal / Chief Judicial Magistrate, Dindigul.

ORDER

The above petition has been filed seeking orders to permit the petitioner to withdraw 50% of the amount which was deposited by the respondent / Transport Corporation.

2. Heard the learned counsel appearing for the petitioner and the learned counsel appearing for the respondent.

3. It is evident from the records that this Court in C.M.P.(MD)No.14742 of 2025 vide order dated 09.09.2025 directed the respondent to deposit 50% of the award amount together with accrued interest and costs to the credit of M.C.O.P.No.348 of 2021 on the file of the Motor Accident Claims Tribunal / Chief Judicial Magistrate, Dindigul. In pursuance of the said direction, the respondent deposited 50% of the award amount together with accrued interest and costs.

4. The learned counsel appearing for the respondent would submit that they are not having any objections to withdraw 50% of the amount.



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5. Considering the submissions made on either side, the petitioner is permitted to withdraw 50% of the amount that was deposited by the respondent with accrued interest and costs on filing necessary application before the Tribunal.

6. Accordingly, this petition is ordered.
