ORDER

This Writ Petition has been filed to forbear the first respondent from registering any document in respect of the land in Survey Nos.291/6, 291/6A and 291/6B, Mangalam Village, Kalaiyarkovil Taluk, Sivagangai District pending disposal of the revision preferred by the petitioner before the 2nd respondent in Na.Ka.No.C5/274/2026.

2. Mr.M.Lingadurai, learned Special Government Pleader takes notice for the respondents 1 to 3. Since no adverse orders are going to be passed, notice to the respondents 4 to 6 is dispensed with.

3. By consent on either sides, this Writ Petition is taken up for final disposal at the admission stage itself.

4. The learned counsel appearing for the petitioner would submit that since a revision preferred by the petitioner before the second respondent is pending, the first respondent should not register any document in respect of the subject property. He therefore, prayed for appropriate orders.
