PETITION FOR BAIL Under Sec.483 of BNSS

PRAYER :- To Bail in Spl.S.C.No.60 of 2025 on the file of the District and Sessions Judge cum Special Court for Exclusive Trial of Cases under POCSO Act, Ramanathapuram, the file of the Respondent Police.

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ORDER : The Court made the following order :-

The petitioners, who were arrested and remanded to judicial custody on 19.06.2025 for the offences punishable under Sections 9(m) 9(s) r/w. 10 and Section 18 of POCSO Act, 2012 and Section 10 and 18 of POCSO Act, 2012 and 3(1)(r), 3(2)(va), SC/ST Act, dated 19.06.2025 in Spl.S.C.No.60 of 2025 on the file of the District and Sessions Judge cum Special Court for Exclusive Trial of Cases under POCSO Act, Ramanathapuram, seek bail.

2. The case of the prosecution is that on 19.06.2025, the defacto complainant's daughter went to school and at that time, the petitioner took the victim child into the motor pump set and sexually abused her. Hence, the complaint.

3. The learned counsel for the petitioners submitted that the petitioners are innocent person and they have not committed any offences as alleged by the prosecution. He further submitted that the petitioners are in judicial custody from 19.06.2025. Hence, he seeks bail to the

petitioner.

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4. The learned Additional Public Prosecutor submitted that the defacto complainant's daughter went to school and at that time, the petitioner took the victim child into the motor pump set and sexually abused her. Therefore, he opposed for grant of bail to the petitioners.

5. Taking into consideration of the fact that there was no penetrative assault and also considering the period of incarceration suffered by the petitioners, this Court is inclined to grant bail to the petitioners, subject to the following conditions:

6. Accordingly, the petitioners are ordered to be released on bail on executing a bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand only) each with two sureties, each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the learned District and Sessions Judge cum Special Court for Exclusive Trial of Cases under POCSO Act, Ramanathapuram, and on further conditions that :-

[a] the petitioners and the sureties shall affix their photographs and left thumb impression in the surety bond and the Magistrate may obtain a copy of their Aadhaar card or bank pass book to ensure their identity.

[b] the petitioners shall report before the respondent police daily at 10.30 a.m., until further orders. The petitioner shall not threaten the victim or the victim's family. He shall not enter the street, school/college, house, or any place where the victim is normally available. No relaxation shall be considered for the next two months.

[c] the petitioners shall not tamper with the evidence or witness either during investigation or trial.

[d] the petitioners shall not abscond either during investigation or trial.

[e] On breach of any of the aforesaid conditions, the learned Magistrate/Trial Court is entitled to take appropriate action against the petitioner in accordance with law as if the conditions have been imposed and the petitioner is released on bail by the learned Magistrate/Trial Court himself as laid down by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in P.K.Shaji vs. State of Kerala

[f] If the accused thereafter absconds, a fresh FIR can be registered under Section 269 BNS.
