COMMON ORDER

These Civil Revision Petitions have been filed seeking a direction to the learned 2nd Additional District Judge, Tuticorin, to dispose of the cases in I.A.Nos.3 of 2022, 4 of 2023 and 5 of 2023 in A.S.No.45 of 2020, within a time frame fixed by this Court.

2.This Court, vide order, dated 18.02.2026, had directed the learned 2nd Additional District Judge, Tuticorin, to send a year wise pendency report of the pending cases and in compliance of the same, the learned 2nd Additional District Judge, Tuticorin, had sent a report vide proceedings in D.No.203/2026, dated 25.02.2026, annexing the breakup details with regard to the pendency of the cases arising from the year 2022 to 2026. From the perusal of the same, it is seen that the total number of pending cases is 344 and the pendency of the cases in the year 2022 is 75.
