2. Recording the same, this Criminal Appeal stands abated and hence, closed. Consequently, the connected miscellaneous petition is closed.

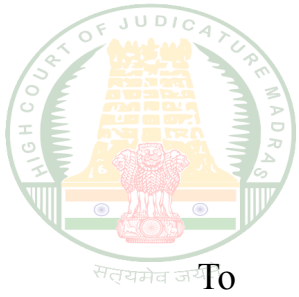
