**Prayer:** Criminal Original Petition is filed under Section 528 of BNSS, 2023, to accept the surrender of the petitioners before the learned Special court for S.C/S.T (Prevention of Atrocities) Act i.e. the 1<sup>st</sup> Additional District and Sessions Judge at Trichy in connection with the Cr.No.59 of 2026 on the file of the 2<sup>nd</sup> respondent police and



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to consider the bail application filed by the petitioners on the same day.

**ORDER**

This Criminal Original Petition has been filed to direct the learned 1<sup>st</sup> Additional District and Sessions Judge, Special court for S.C/S.T (Prevention of Atrocities) Act, Trichy, to consider the bail application of the petitioners on the same day of their surrender before that Court in connection with Crime No.59/2026 on the file of the 2<sup>nd</sup> respondent police.

2. Since there is no adverse order passed against the 3<sup>rd</sup> respondent, notice to the 3<sup>rd</sup> respondent is dispensed with.

3. The learned counsel for the petitioners submitted that due to a petty dispute between the petitioners and the *de facto* complainant, the petitioners used abusive language towards the *de facto* complainant and also criticized the caste name of the *de facto* complainant and attacked the *de facto* complainant and also



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threatened them with dire consequences. Based on these allegations, an FIR has been registered against the petitioners.

4. Heard the learned counsel on either side and carefully perused the materials available on record.

5. Considering the limited scope of the relief sought for, this Court hereby direct the 1<sup>st</sup> Additional District and Sessions Judge, Special court for S.C/S.T (Prevention of Atrocities) Act, Trichy, to issue prior notice to the *de facto* complainant and thereafter to consider the bail application of the petitioners on the same day of their surrender before that Court in connection with Crime No.59 of 2026 on the file of the 2<sup>nd</sup> respondent police. The petitioner shall surrender before the learned Trial Court within a period of 15 days from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.

6. Accordingly, this Criminal Original Petition is disposed of.
