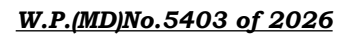

ORDER

This Writ Petition has been filed seeking issuance of a Writ of Mandamus, directing the respondents 1 to 3 to conduct enquiry and to cancel the Patta Nos. 1348 and 1421 stood in the name of the fourth respondent and to issue patta to the petitioner and her mother in respect of property in Survey Nos.493/1B measuring a total extent of 0.19.0 Ares and 492/1A measuring a total extent of 0.19.0 Ares, situated at Kalathur Village, Watrap Taluk, Viruthunagar District, by considering the petitioner's representation dated 28.08.2025, within a stipulated time as framed by this Court.

2. By consent, the Writ Petition is taken up for final disposal at the admission stage itself.

3. Since no adverse orders are going to be passed against the fourth respondent, notice to the fourth respondent is hereby dispensed with.

Recording the above submission, and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the matter, this writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the second respondent to conduct an enquiry and pass appropriate orders, on merits and in accordance with law after providing reasonable opportunity of hearing to the petitioner, the fourth respondent and any other persons, who may be affected



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by such decision, within a period of sixteen weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order. There shall be no order as to costs.
